- 2. Election of Officers

- 3. Web Pages
 - a. The content of the default web pages was discussed
 - b. Motion: Include option to include deposition amounts for all three subnetworks.

- 4. Site Classification Framework
 - a. The goals of the site classification framework were discussed. Two goals were outlined: determining the basic level of classification for a site, and providing refining information on a site. Extensive discussion ensured about the classification scheme, purpose, and what information will be used in the scheme. The consensus of the group was to not use a relative ranking system. More discussion then ensued regarding how sites will be classified historically. The *ad hoc* committee will take comments from the group and report back to the Committee in Spring 2000.
- 5. Audit of Data Management
 - a. John Robertson reported on his progress on validating the NADP database for internal consistency and logical sense.
 - b. <u>Motion:</u> Audit data management operations at the CAL and Program Office in Spring 2001.
 - i. Motion passed.
- 6. Trend Presentations on the Web
 - a. Bob Larson led a brief discussion on presenting trends on the web.
 - b. Luther Smith presented the trend graphing proposal from the *ad hoc* committee. The group discussed a number of points in a wide-ranging discussion.
 - c. <u>Motion:</u> Use a 3-year moving average centered on the year where the line will be drawn and the completeness criteria will be calculated from the aggregated years for the period. For example, Plot a 3-year precipitation-weighted mean for the previous, current and subsequent year using completeness criteria calculated from the entire 3-year period.
 - i. Motion passed.
 - d. <u>Motion:</u> Provide a continuous line for the entire period with a change in quality of the line to indicate the failure of completeness criteria for the period.
